Humidifier Rebate Program

The Regional Municipality of York is pleased to announce our water-efficient humidifier rebate program. By replacing your current, inefficient humidifier with a new water-efficient model approved by York Region, you can qualify for a rebate of either \$30 or \$70. The program offers:



- \$30 for an approved, furnace-mounted humidifier that sends less than 50 litres of water to the drain per day
- \$70 for an approved, furnace-mounted humidifier that sends less than 10 litres of water to the drain per day

Switching from a typical flow-through humidifier to a water-efficient model can save up to 200 litres of water per day. Please visit www.waterfortomorrow.ca for complete details and a list of qualifying models.
